

## **A letter about housing on Mother's Day**

I am very concerned about low income people being displaced from the Little Mountain social housing, and concerned about its future.

This story is a familiar one, starting off with too familiar of a situation, divorce. After my parents separated my mother went through a nomadic phase. As a result I went to 7 schools in 4 years. Then we, Mom and 4 children moved into "The Project", the Little Mountain Housing Development. Life wasn't that easy, but we had stability. Mom never went on welfare, but worked part time. We lived there from 1964 to 1970.

Mom now has dementia and has been living in a nursing home since 2002. She loved well and is well loved by all around her. We 4 children went on to become a mechanic, a carpenter, a teacher and a nurse.

I am very thankful for the stability that social housing provided our struggling family with. There needs to be stable housing for the working poor!
